A Shepherding Community

By baptism we are made shepherds like our Lord. We are called to care for one another in a special way. As a church, we are called to be a shepherding community, working together with the priest—to search, find, feed, and bring each person to the great home prepared by the Great Shepherd, our Lord Jesus Christ.

What is then our spirituality together as a community? The following point explains it beautifully:

A priest is a sacramental presence of the Good Shepherd, our Lord Jesus Christ. But a parish priest can only be effective in his pastoral obligations if he could inflame the baptismal grace of the church members, the community as a whole. Every member of the Christian community had been anointed priest, prophet, and shepherd-king when she/he received the sacrament of baptism. Therefore, the spirituality of the priest is experienced not only in being a shepherd to the church community, but in being shepherd to a community of shepherds. As pastor of the community, the priest not only makes the Great Shepherd present through his ministry but also challenges, supports, and empowers the total community as it takes on the shepherding image of Christ.
