Are you Mary or Martha? Jesus had three friends who lived in Bethany. He would occasionally stay in their home when He



was in Judea. Lazarus, Mary and Martha were brother and sisters. They lived together in the same house which probably was owned by Martha. During this particular visit, Jesus is teaching us three great lessons in our relationship with the Lord and on how to effectively evangelize God's great message to the world:

1. Without Him we can do nothing (JOHN 15:5).

We do not have to choose between worshiping the Lord like Mary or serving the Lord like Martha. Neither does there need to be such a conflict between our physical or secular needs and our spiritual growth.

2. Do not let so many things worry us

Where faith grows, anxiety lessens. This is one of the chief lessons Jesus taught earlier in His ministry during what we call the sermon on the mount; "Do not be anxious then, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?'... But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." (MATTHEW 6:31-33).

3. Have a balanced approach to serving the Lord

Do not neglect what matters most because there is time to do everything. God has blessed us with so many resources to get the job done. The Lord is more concerned about Martha's state of mind and priorities than He is about being served a feast. Being with God means everything to all of us.

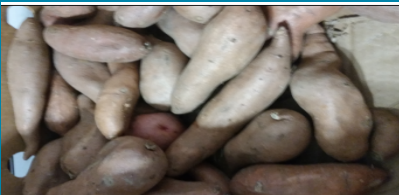
